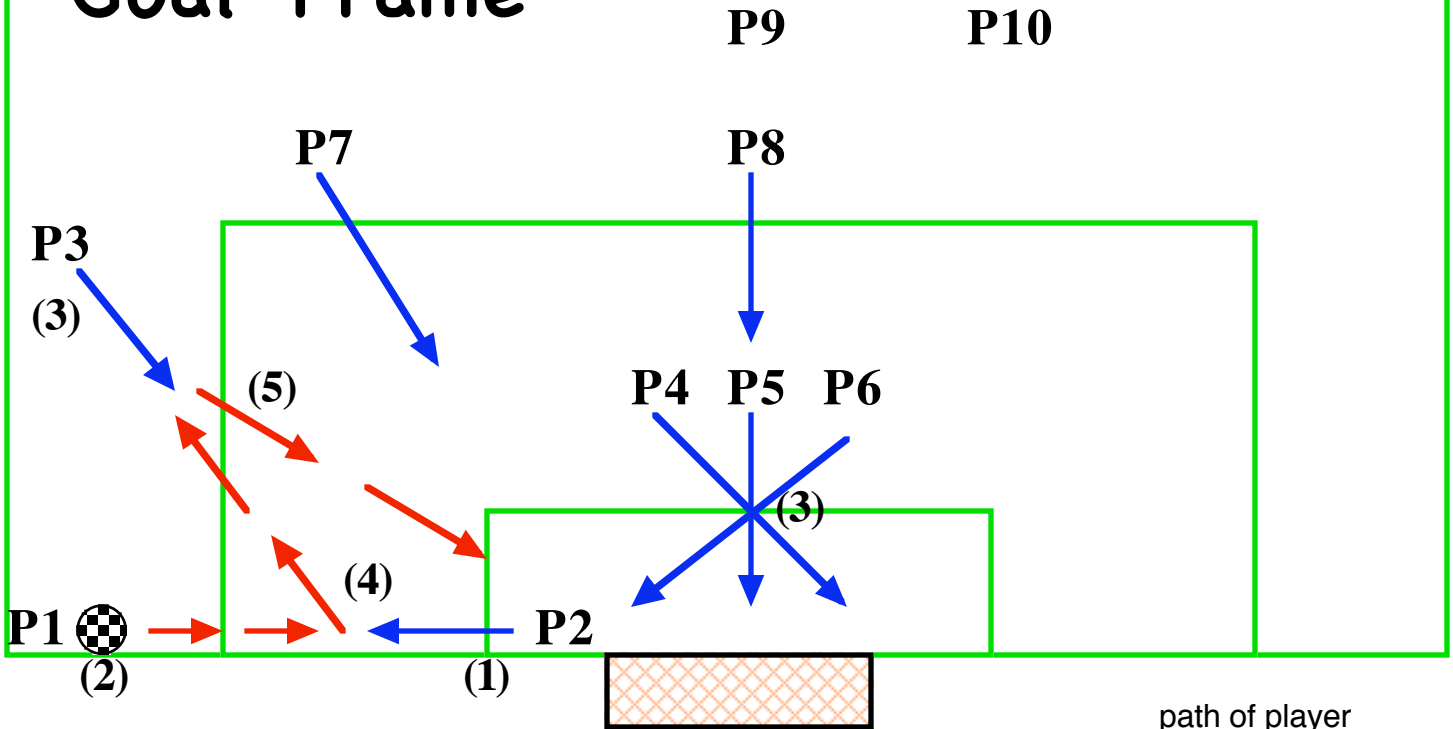


# Corner Kick Play

## "Goal Frame"



**SETUP:**

- Player 1 (P1) takes the corner kick
- Player 2 (P2) lines up just outside the near post
- Player 3 (P3) lines up even with 15-yard box, close to the sideline
- Players 4, 5, 6 line up in straight line across penalty mark
- Players 7 & 8 (P7, P8) line up at top of box; Players 9 & 10 (P9, P10), remain back, centrally located

**THE PLAY**

- (1) P2 makes run toward corner as soon as P1 raises hand to indicate the kick is coming
- (2) P1 kicks ball to P2
- (3) P3 makes diagonal run toward box while...
  - > P4 makes diagonal run to back post; P6 runs behind P4 and goes diagonally toward near post; P5 makes straight run to middle of goal; the goal is now framed
- (4) P2 lays ball back to P3
- (5) P3 fires shot at goal

**OTHER OPTIONS**

- > if P2 is marked closely, P1 can make a diagonally back kick to P3 who shoots on goal
- > if P3 is marked closely, P2 can lay ball back to P1 who shoots on goal

**TRANSITION**

- > after taking the corner kick, P1 should loop around and get to the top of the box as quickly as possible
- > after taking the shot on goal P3 should slide across to the top of the box
